

Policy 23 : Privacy

23.0 Overview

Please read this Privacy Policy and the Terms and Conditions before using the site.

The Privacy Policy set out below shall apply to all users of the site. The terms 'you', 'your' and 'user' refer to any individual and/or business accessing this site for any reason. References to 'we', 'us' and 'our' are references to BAA. The information we collect from you is only that required by us in order to provide you with the information you have requested and to improve the service we provide. Except as provided in this Privacy Policy, we do not supply your personal information to any other person.

23.1 Personal Information

In general, we gather information about all of our users collectively, such as what areas you visit most frequently and what services you access the most. We only use this anonymously and aggregated with other users' information to protect your privacy. The information collected helps us determine what features and services are of most benefit to you in order to create the best possible service for you.

23.2 Specific Information

In some instances, such as when you register as a member of BAA to access the members area of our website or enter a competition, we may require more specific information about you, such as name, date of birth, e-mail address, postcode etc. We use this information to verify your BAA membership, to make you aware of new services, which may be of interest to you, or to contact you regarding site changes and updates. The BAA produces an information newsletter, which is electronically circulated to all members. You may opt out of receiving these updates at any time by sending an email to secretary@aikido-baa.org.uk

23.3 General Information

We do not disclose your individual visits to our site, or personal information that you provide, such as your name, e-mail address, postcode, etc., to any outside parties, except when we believe the law requires it. We are not responsible for any information inputted outside our site.

23.4 Online Surveys

The British Aikido Association values your opinion and comments, so we may from time to time conduct online surveys. Your participation in these surveys is entirely optional. Typically, the information is aggregated and used to make improvements to the site and to develop appealing content, features and promotions for you. Your contribution to any survey will be anonymous unless otherwise stated in the survey.

23.5 Feedback

Please submit any feedback to us. Feedback is used primarily for internal purposes to aid us in improving the site. Any feedback submitted becomes our property and we may use feedback, such as success stories, for marketing purposes, or to contact you for further feedback. We will seek your written or email approval before using your personal success story for marketing purposes.



23.6 IP Addresses and Log Files

We may collect IP addresses of visitors to our site to help diagnose problems with our servers and for system administration. We shall only use these addresses for technical and tracking purposes unless otherwise required by the law. We capture industry standard information contained in the server log file, such as browser type, pages visited, entry and exit points and visit duration solely for the purposes of analysis. Information contained in log files is intended for internal use only and will not be disclosed to our Partners. The aggregate logged information is not linked to any personally identifiable information.

23.7 Membership database

Information is retained on members of the BAA; this is for administrative, insurance and legal purposes. The information will include contact details including e.g. e-mail, date of birth and club. The database will also hold information regarding coaching and technical qualifications and levels. This information is kept for association administrative purposes only.

23.8 Access to Information held by us
